






#### Know your audience!

#### What should be incorporated into an elevator pitch?

- Mission
- Demographic
- Problem statement
- Goals of proposal (solution)
- Call to action

#### Elevator Pitch no no's

- Exaggerations
- Big picture statements that cannot be supported

### **Elevator Pitch Exercise**

## **Elevator Pitch Exercise**

#### Type Here: MUDDIEST POINT . .

- Did not say what the solution was EVERYone . . . so how? What would the 100k do?
- Did not say their name/Who they are
- Unrealistic goal with the funds- solution NOT practical
- Also no specific solution
- Passive
- Do everything you can ultimately means nothing not measurable or realistic
- exaggerated with out supporting info
