



Funding for Green's Funding Process Sheet

Read through Funding for Green's funding process outlined below, then continue with the Introductory Call exercise.

The Funding for Green Foundation has four funding cycles per year. Organizations may only apply once per calendar year. Application deadlines for each cycle are listed below. If the date falls on a weekend, the deadline is the next business day.

- **September 30, 11:59 p.m. central time**
- **December 30, 11:59 p.m. central time**
- **March 30, 11:59 p.m. central time**
- **June 30, 11:59 p.m. central time**

The Board reviews all of the preliminary proposals submitted through the grants management system to determine which requests align most closely with the Foundation's funding priorities. Three to four weeks after the submission deadlines, the ED contacts all of the applicants to notify them if their request will advance to the second round of consideration. Organizations that don't progress to the second round can submit requests in the next calendar year.

The ED arranges an in-person or Zoom meeting with the organizations that advance to the second round of consideration to learn more about the plans described in the request. The organization should expect to provide financial statements or a recent financial audit. The ED will notify organizations about the board's decision regarding their request within eight weeks of submitting their application.

RESPONSIBILITIES OF GRANT RECIPIENTS

Grants shall be used solely for the purposes and for the period of time outlined in the proposal unless the Grantee has received permission from the Foundation. Grantees are required to submit a complete evaluation and financial report at the conclusion of the grant period through the online portal.

APPLICATION PROCEDURES
